Now we look to blaze ahead by bringing fiber through Hood River, connecting to customers on our way, and feeding our distribution sites with faster speeds for end users. We're looking to increase capacity to businesses and residences in the downtown Hood River area, Avalon/Belmont neighborhoods, May Street West neighborhoods, and eventually the Port area West of the Hood River. What this means to you is 100M speeds (and higher) are available in some locations and will be spreading to other areas. Stay tuned as we send out updates on when fiber will be available in your neighborhood!
